East Coast Cutover is One Week Away

- The cutover date for the move of the CBOE, CFE and OneChicago data centers to the Equinix NY4 Data Center in New Jersey is one week away. The last sessions for weekday mock trading and weekend testing sessions to prepare for the **Monday, December 3, 2012** move are:
 - **Weekday sessions:** *This Tuesday (11/27), Wednesday (11/28) and Thursday (11/29), from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. (ET)*
 - **Weekend sessions:** *Next Saturday, December 1, from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (ET)*
- A “hot cutover” will occur such that CBOE, CFE, and One Chicago will operate from the current Chicago data center through the **end of business on Friday, November 30** and commence business operations on Monday, December 3 from the NY4 Data Center. Please note that resting GTC orders will be cancelled on Friday, November 30 and firms will be responsible for re-entry. See CBOE [Information Circular IC12-101](#) for details.

Consolidated Audit Trail Industry Call and WebEx to be Held Next Week

- The national securities exchanges and FINRA (collectively the “SROs”) will be holding a conference call and WebEx presentation on **Thursday, November 29** at 4:15 p.m. ET (3:15 p.m. CT) regarding SEC Rule 613, which requires the SROs to submit an NMS Plan to the SEC to create, implement and maintain a consolidated audit trail (CAT).
- During the call, the SROs will provide an update on CAT NMS Plan development efforts including the process and timeline for issuing the request for proposal to solicit bids to build and operate the CAT; baseline reporting requirements currently under consideration; and future industry events where interested industry participants will have the opportunity to share feedback on implementation issues.
