CFE's London Hub Launches Next Friday

- CBOE Futures Exchange is launching a communications hub in London, England next Friday, February 1.
- The Hub is a cross connection (telephone switch and communication lines) from the Equinix facility in England to the CBOE Command Center at the Equinix facility in New Jersey. The Hub will provide direct access to CFE's trading system and market data and index data made available by Market Data Express. At a later date, we plan to make direct access to the CBOE trading system and market data available.

Market-Maker Orders Permitted to Rest in COB

- Also next Friday, February 1, CBOE will permit the Complex Order Book (COB) to accept resting orders for the accounts of CBOE TPH Market-Makers (origin code "M") and non-CBOE TPH Market-Makers (origin code "N," *i.e.*, market-makers or specialists on another options exchange) in all classes other than VIX, SPX, SPXQ, SPXW. Previously, M and N orders were not permitted to rest in COB.

The information that must be provided by bidders in response to the RFP with respect to each requirement will also be discussed.
