Expanded Trading Hours for VIX Futures

➤ On June 22, pending regulatory review, CBOE Futures Exchange (CFE) plans to expand trading hours for VIX futures to nearly 24 hours, five days a week.

➤ Specifically, the trading week for VIX futures will begin on Sunday at 5:00 p.m. and end on Friday at 3:15 p.m. CFE will be closed for trading on Monday through Thursday for 15 minutes between 3:15 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. and trading for the new business day will begin at 3:30 p.m. on Monday through Thursday. CFE will close at 3:15 p.m. on Friday and will remain closed until 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, when the new trading week will begin. Regular trading hours in VIX futures will continue to be from 8:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. Monday through Friday and trading in VIX futures during all other times will be extended trading hours. New Quote Risk Monitor Features

➤ CBOE will soon introduce several new features to the Quote Risk Monitor (QRM) functionality. QRM is the function that cancels a Market-Maker's remaining quotes and/or orders when certain risk limits set by the Market-Maker are reached. The effective date for the enhanced features will be announced in a future circular. However, firms may begin testing these new features in the CBOE test environment.
